In Mark 13:9-13, Jesus gives us three actions we should take when the world gets bad...

1. Be _____ (v. 9).

Mockery of every sort was added to their deaths. Covered with the skins of beasts, they were torn by dogs and perished, or were nailed to crosses, or were doomed to the flames and burnt, to serve as a nightly illumination, when daylight had expired. Nero offered his gardens for the spectacle, and was exhibiting a show in the circus, while he mingled with the people in the dress of a charioteer or stood aloft on a car. Hence, even from criminals who deserved extreme and exemplary punishment, there arose a feeling of compassion.
