

WEDNESDAY'S MAIN POINT: JESUS PRAYED



Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane

Read Luke 22: 39-46

In the garden of Gethsemane, Jesus knew he was going to be punished on the cross. When we experience times of trouble and suffering, Jesus has given us an example of how to respond. God has given us the ability to speak directly to him through prayer. During his time of stress, Jesus went alone in the garden and prayed for God's will. He asked His disciples to join Him in prayer, but they fell asleep. God heard Jesus' prayer and sent an angel to comfort and support Him.

How can we respond in times of trouble? We can pray to God the Father just like Jesus did. He is able to comfort us when hurting, guide us when confused, and correct us when we are wrong. Just as God the Father gave direction to Jesus, He will give direction to us.

Pray: God, help me to speak to you with my concerns and suffering first.
